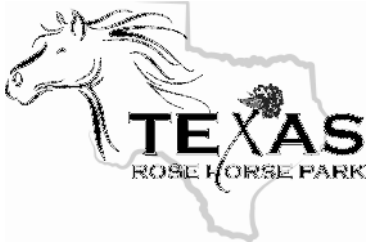

## **RULES AND GUIDELINES**

- ◆ It is the responsibility of the exhibitor, trainer, and spectators to conduct themselves in a civilized and sportsmanship manner.
- ◆ On the show grounds, mounted riders must wear protective headgear at all times. ASTM/SEI approved.
- ◆ All dogs must be on a leash held in the hand or otherwise confined.
- ◆ **Proof of an original negative coggins within one year is mandatory by the State of Texas. This must be shown before any entries will be accepted for check in.** This will be strictly enforced.
- ◆ Please be familiar with all NTHJC rules.
- ◆ All trainers/coaches must be members of NTHJC regardless if they are showing.
- ◆ All riders and horses must be members of NTHJC to compete in the medal classes.
- ◆ A horse may cross enter into divisions with fence heights of 6" difference, except the 18" division. A rider may enter a maximum of 2 horses or ponies per hunter class except the open divisions. If a rider has ever won a year-end award (1st-8th) in a hunter, jumper or equitation class or 2', the rider is not eligible for 2' hunter, equitation or Medal class
- ◆ Failure to leave the arena when the announcer says schooling is closed may result in elimination.
- ◆ All children must be accompanied and supervised by an adult.
- ◆ Proper show attire is required. Polo shirts may be worn only in jumper classes.
- ◆ Chaps may not be worn in any class.
- ◆ All classes, except open and jumper classes, with 20 competed rounds will be divided.
- ◆ **Add-Back classes** cost \$25.00 per class (\$10.00 x # in class = total prize money). No points will be given for add-back classes. There must be 6 entries for the class to make. **All add-back classes are open.**
- ◆ **3'3" It's All About the Horse Hunter Classic.** The cost of the class is \$25.00. There will be 2 rounds. The top 12 from the first round will be called back in reverse order for the second round. The highest combined score will win the class. This class is open to all riders.
- ◆ **Schooling:** Open schooling is allowed Friday between 3:00 & 7:00 in both arenas and warm-up arenas and the morning before each area begins. Schooling closes 30 min prior to each arena start time. No Schooling Jumpers.
- ◆ **Gambler's Choice.** The cost of the class is \$40.00. This class is open to all riders. Height at 3'3" to 3'6".

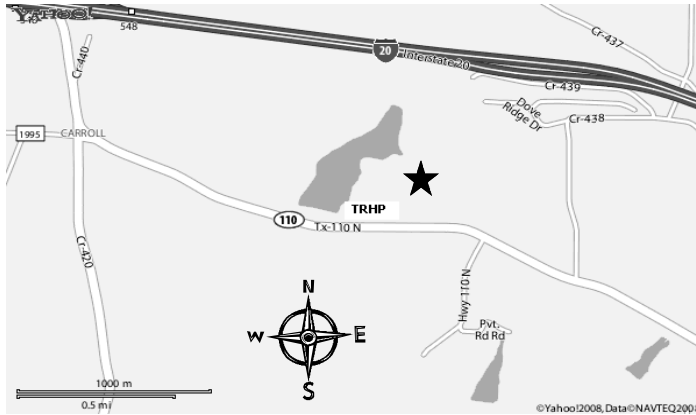
