The Southwest Miniature Horse Club is expecting over 200 horses from Texas, Oklahoma and Louisiana. Several owners of these mini dynamos, (ranging

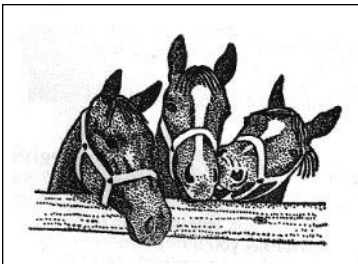
in size from 17"-34"), come from as far away as Germany and Holland.
